In order to be confirmed at West Parish Church, students must complete 10 hours of community service plus 10 hours of parish service. These hours may be accumulated beginning July 1 following 8th grade. Opportunities for confirmation service projects are periodically posted in the weekly Church Bulletin and monthly *Life Together* newsletter.

Ideas for parish service projects may include, but are not limited to, the following:

- Reader, Usher, Greeter, Musician, Singer
- Yard Sale Worker
- Set-up, clean-up or assist during special services or activities (e.g. Ham & Bean Suppers)

Ideas for community service projects may include, but are not limited to, the following:

- Volunteer activities at local shelters, nursing homes, Habitat for Humanity etc.
- Mission Trips
- Service projects run by West Parish Church
- Service projects run by the United Church of Christ
- Service projects run by another church (UCC or other)

Please note that the following activities **DO NOT fulfill the requirement** for confirmation service projects:

- Personal or family-related service (e.g., babysitting, housecleaning, lawn cutting)
- Cleaning up trash from local parks or roadways.
- Fundraisers for sports teams, schools or clubs like Boy Scouts or 4H.
- Work for which you have been paid or tipped
